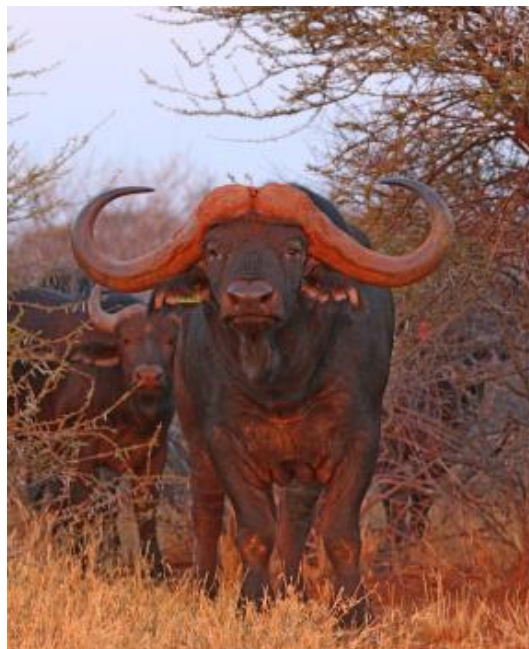


## WEGDRAAI BOERDERY

In 2000 Pieter van der Walt started a buffalo breeding project in the Lowveld. The very best cows from the Kruger National Park were used for breeding. Tjaart and Pieter took turns at full-time involvement with the breeding project and it was then that Wegdraai buffalo breeding took off. Pieter and Tjaart between them have about thirty years of experience in breeding buffalos. Their experience and dedication contributed to Wegdraai currently having a herd of more than a hundred, all of them bred here.



Outstanding quality is clearly to be seen in the herd and we are proud to be able to state that the average length of horn in our adult buffalo cows is 36” – in the case of our biggest cow it is 42 ¼” (as measured in 2013).
